Being part of Amazonia, the capital of Amapá is a stopping off point for migrating birds, which join the local flamingos, toucans, ibises, sea and river turtles, giant alligators, manatees, ant eaters and armadillos which make up the rich fauna of the region and lend

special colouring to the green of the forest. In Macapá, the waters of the Amazon river bathe on the beaches of Fazendinha and Araxá, which afford very good bathing.

**REIS MONDO (fiction)...SBLX**

This community finished their airfield only a week ago and airlines have been invited to start operations. You'll have top priority.

**PALMAIRA ISLAND (fiction) SBKK**

...Those of you who flew in Episode 4 know this thriving island which moves many passengers in both jets and prop aircraft. New airlines are trying to come into this well kept airfield.

**CHAVEZ (SNXW)**

Chavez...A small town trying to join the community by air.

**Soure (SNSW)**

Soure is a Brazilian municipality located in the state of Pará. Its population as of 2008 is estimated to be 22,244 people. The area of the municipality is 3,512.863 km<sup>2</sup>. The city belongs to the mesoregion Marajó and to the microregion of Arari.

## BELEM (SBBE)



---

(real)Belém, in Pará state, is one of Brazil's busiest ports - and it's about 60 miles upriver from the Atlantic ocean! The river is the Pará, part of the greater Amazon river system, separated from the larger part of the Amazon delta by Ilha de Marajó. Belém is built on a number of small islands intersected by channels and other rivers.

Founded in 1616, Belém was the first European colony on the Amazon but didn't become part of the Brazilian nation until 1775. As the gateway to the Amazon, the port and city grew tremendously in size and importance during the nineteenth century rubber boom, and is now a large city with millions of inhabitants. The newer part of the city has modern buildings and skyscrapers. The colonial portion retains the charm of tree filled squares, churches and traditional blue tiles. On the outskirts of the city, the river supports a group of people called cablocas, who live their lives almost untouched by the busy activities of the city.



**SAO GERA(fiction) SBHH.....**This oil rich area has started a brand new airport and many airlines are trying to get space to bring in people and goods.

**MORAIRA( Fiction) SBXT...**All bids for new Air Routes will be designated here by Lady Del Calzón , the 36 year old mayor. She is so pretty she is called “the Amazon’s Sunshine!!!” A big party will be held at the soccer stadium so make sure you land here.

### **GURUPA (SNGU)**

Ilha Grande do Gurupá is the second largest island of the River Amazon delta. It lies in the Brazilian state of Pará, west of Marajó and near the confluence of the Amazon and the Xingu. The island has an area of 4,864 square kilometres (1,878 sq mi)

This place is situated in Almerim, Para, Brazil, its geographical coordinates are 0° 52' 0" South, 52° 31' 0" West and its original name (with diacritics) is Monte Dourado.

### **Belo Monte (Fiction) SBXU**

...A brand new community in the mining areas which is just starting to communicate by air. Notice that it now has its grass airfield all set up. You might like to take a small plane to the original one which is very near by—up in a hill!!!!

### **Porto Grande (SNPG)**

This place is situated in Macapa, Amapa, Brazil, its geographical coordinates are 0° 42' 0" North, 51° 24' 0" West ....Things are slow here, for the place is just a big hole in the ground!!!!
