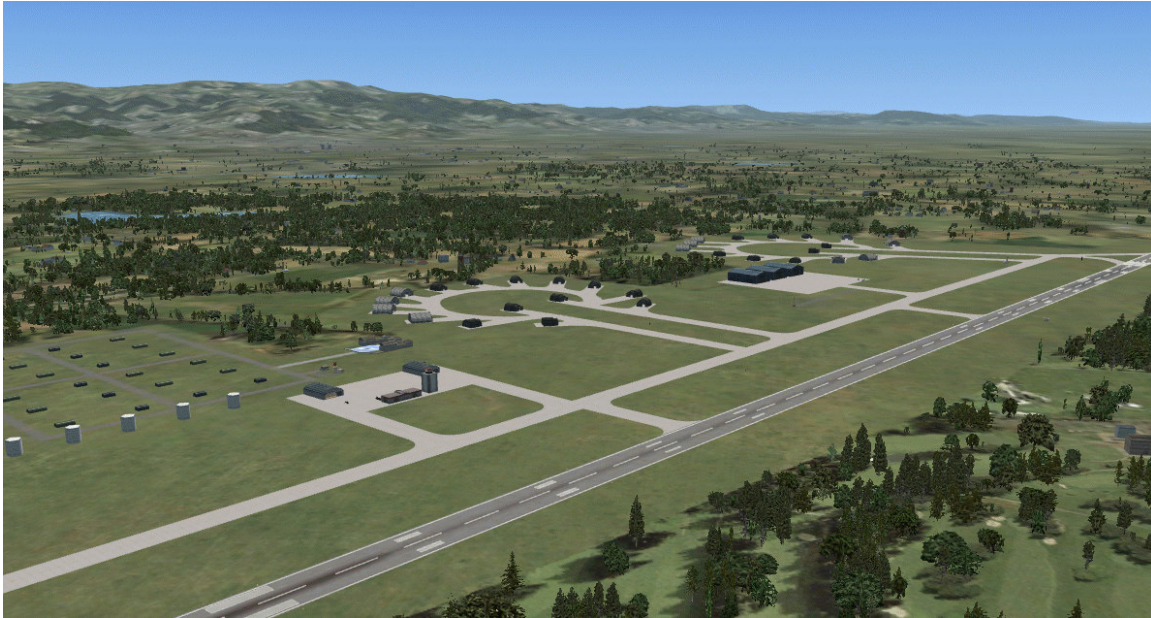


CFB Baden-Soellingen FSX Scenery V1.0



This scenery is a reincarnation of the Canadian Forces Base at Baden-Soellingen as it existed in the 60's and 70's during the cold war era and is made for MS FSX.

Location: N48 46.24 E008 4.33

ICAO: EDSB

Elevation: 408 Feet MSL

Runway: 3/21, length 9,800 feet (length), 148 feet (width), asphalt.

NAVAIDS:

VORTAC "SB", 109.3 MHz, range 169 NM (this VORTAC is used for Canadian Forces approach plates)

VORDME "KBD", 115.8 MHz, range 195 NM (default FSX navaid).

NDB "KBA", 431KHz, range 38 NM (default FSX navaid).

NDB "SIN", 440 KHz, range 40 NM (this NDB is used for the Canadian Forces approach plates).

INSTALLATION

1. Copy the EDSB_FSX folder to your Addon Scenery folder.
2. Activate your new scenery with FSX.
3. There are many objects in this scenery. You may want to adjust your scenery settings. The number of displayed objects will increase as you change your settings from "SPARSE" towards "VERY DENSE".

CHARTS

Vintage Canadian Forces approach and takeoff procedure plates are included in this package. They utilize the navigational aids that are added in this scenery (see above).
