Installation

Procedure with installed scenery

If you have installed the first version of FreeZ, you have to delete the folders "scenery" and "texture" in the directory "FS9\Addon Scenery\FreeZ". In the folder "FS9\Addon Scenery\FreeZ" there's a file called "Remove_old_files.bat", which takes this job. Please make sure, those folders have been deleted before continuing with the installation.

You don't have to add the scenery to the scenery library again, if the old version is still present.

Autogen still needs to be activated otherwise the ground will be missing.

New installation

Unzip the folder „FreeZ“ into the folder „FS9\Addon Scenery“.

Then the file "FS9\Addon Scenery\FreeZ\Modules.bat" has to be run.

If FSUIPC isn't installed yet, the file "FS9\Addon Scenery\FreeZ\FSUIPC.bat" has to be run too.

Start FS9 and open the scenery library, which can be found in the settings of the main screen. Add the folder "FreeZ" to the scenery library.

In the graphic settings, autogen needs to be activated.

Start FS – have fun!

AES

There is one free AES version for FreeZ, fully functional but with advertising on the jetways. If you want to have FreeZ and AES without advertising, you have to pay 3 credits.

AES Midfield

We had to displace the containers and other objects in order not to have conflicts with cars from AES. Just run the file „M1_AES_yes.bat“ and you shouldn't have any conflicts. Run the file „M1_AES_no.bat“ to move those objects to their original place.

Solution of known issues with a new installation

MICE/Mohler

The file „AP950150.BGL“ which is placed in the folder „FS9\Addon Scenery\FreeZ\source“ needs to be moved or copied to „FS9\Scenery\Eurw\Scenery“
Alternatively you can run the script „Mohler_Mice.bat“.

CH-Professional (Flylogic)

The file „LSZH.bgl“ in the directory „FS9\Addon Scenery\Switzerland_Pro\Airports\Scenery“ needs to be renamed or deleted.
In addition we recommend to install autogen for the region of Zurich.
These two jobs can be done by running „CHPRO.bat“ which is placed in the directory “FreeZ”.

Runway lighting

Runway 16

- Default: OFF
- ILS 110.50: HIGH INTENSITY
- ADF 0160: Rwy Lights 14 OFF

Runway 34

- Default: OFF
- ILS 110.75: HIGH INTENSITY

Runway 14

- Default: LOW INTENSITY
- ILS 108.30: HIGH INTENSITY

Runway 28

- Default: LOW INTENSITY
- VOR KLO 114.85 HIGH INTENSITY
