René Tanggaard and Juergen Baumbusch are proud to present the flightplans and paints for the entire fleet for PenAir. After several months of investigations for flight schedules and fleet details, the plans will now be ready for you

Peninsula Airways, usually called PenAir, is an American airline based in Anchorage, Alaska, USA. It is Alaska's largest commuter airline operating an extensive scheduled passenger and cargo services to over 85 communities, as well as charter and medevac services. Its main base is Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport, with hubs at Dillingham Airport, Unalaska Airport, King Salmon Airport and Cold Bay Airport. The airline was founded in 1955 by pilot Orin Seybert of Pilot Point. [1] Operations commenced in 1956, concentrating on charter services. Scheduled services were inaugurated in 1973 between King Salmon and the Pribilof Islands communities. In 1985 Penair acquired all the assets of Air Transport Services of Kodiak. In November 1991 PenAir became a code share partner of Alaska Airlines. The partnership has flourished and grown, and today, Penair continues to operate several flights with an Alaska Airlines code.





PenAir is one of the very last airline in the world to operate the venerable Grumman G-21A Goose on scheduled flights. The amphibious aircraft is still used to resupply remote locations on shore where no airstrip does exist. (wikipedia.org)

In this Package you will find all necessary files to put the entire fleet and Flightplans in your Flightsim. Please read this carefully to avoid problems by running PenAir

Cessna 208B CP	1x
Piper PA-31 Navajo	2x
Piper PA-32 Cherokee	9x
Grumman G-21A Goose	1x

This Package consists of Flightplan for the entire fleet, paints for it, new effects for the Grumman Goose and some necessary AFCAD's for Alaskan Airports (especially the water-AFCAD's for the Grumman Goose). Models not included.

For installing the flightplans, you have to be firm in using TTools by Lee Swordy. I have added this package a traffic.bgl for FSX user but not tested in FSX. So you can use it for your own risk.

Installation instructions for the Additional Goodies

**Only for use with Alaskan Airfields (akaflds.zip at flightsim.com) by Gordon Perry !!!**

Use these files to get rid of aircraft hanging in the air above the runway. The file will correct the elevation of the AI traffic at Dutch Harbor (PADU), Dillingham (PADL) and Adak (PADK). At the remaining airports traffic is already working fine.

Be careful what you do as this can affect several sceneries if any of the files below were changes from the default ones ! (Not sure if the "Ultimate Terrain" add-on changes these files). However as long as you just make a backup before you change anything you are safe. Be sure to make a copy of the right files as the file names look quite similar.

## INSTALLATION :

1) IMPORTANT - Backup your original files :

...\Flight Simulator 9\Scenery\Namw\Scenery\AP900130.BGL  
AP903120.BGL  
AP905110.BGL

2) Make an extra check that you backed up the correct files :-)

3) Now overwrite the three files in the default scenery directory :

...\Flight Simulator 9\Scenery\Namw\Scenery\AP900130.BGL  
AP903120.BGL  
AP905110.BGL



If not everything is working the way it is supposed to then copy your backuped files back into the directory.

I have included a backup of the original FS files if everything should go wrong.

Now you only have to copy and paste the whole content of the Folder named "Flight Simulator 9" in your Flightsim.

So that's all Folks. Enjoy your flight over the Alaskan skies and watch out for the aurora borealis.
