"AB" was the first 'low cost airline' to operate in England, and was the forerunner of the more familiar names we know today, such as EasyJet, Ryanair, and Go Fly. This small independant British carrier was created in 1993 by the former executives of Brymon Airways.

I have included 3 texture sets, which re-present the first two aircraft to go into service with the airline. Texture.ab and Texture.bl are how the aircraft appeared when services started in 1994, and Texture.abvalue is how G-OABA looked from about 1997 onwards when the "First for value" tag line was added behind the main title on the fuselage. I have not found any evidence to show that this tag line was ever added to G-OABL.

As usual just one caveat, I am still quite new to this repaint mularky, so please forgive any errors or omissions and whilst I know it is not perfect, I think it looks pretty good. The original aircraft is aliased to the the default 737 sound and panel, but I know there are many fantastic panels and sound packages available in the flightsim library. I have tested it on my systems and it seems fine, no problems at all but as with all these complex addonnns it can be a bit hard on the frame rates on lower spec systems, so I have included DXT3 textures as well.
