

231 OCU Canberras RAF Wyton 1987-88

This package contains 11 repaints for John Young's excellent English Electric Canberra Package

This package contains repaints for 11 Canberra's of 231 OCU based at RAF Wyton around 1987-88. I have also included some basic flight plans for the aircraft, which I think are representative of where you might have seen these aircraft.

231 OCU formed RAF Bassingbourn as the RAF's Canberra training unit on 1st December 1951. They operated the Canberra continuously, with spells at RAF Cottesmore and RAF Marham, until it was disbanded at RAF Wyton on 15 December 1990. The unit was then renamed the Canberra Standardisation Training Flight. It became 231 OCU again on 13 May 1991 and remained until it was finally disbanded on 23rd April 1993.

The aircraft all use the B2 model. Around this time 231 OCU operated 2 Canberra B2s and 9 Canberra T4 aircraft. There isn't a model for the T4 so I have painted the B2 model to represent the T4s.

These repaints were designed for FS9. I don't have FSX so I don't know if they will work with it or not.

I have given the aircraft a parking code of C231, but of course you can change that to whatever you choose to use.

I have enclosed a basic AFCAD, together with a Flatten file and a background polygon for RAF Wyton. In addition MAIW have produced an RAF Wyton scenery as part of their RAF Tutors package. Available from <http://www.militaryaiworks.com/>
