Since 1993 the airport by the Air Force of the Armed Forces as of the Aerodrome and Airport Neubrandenburg-Trollenhagen GmbH is used as a regional airport.

The civilian terminal was inaugurated in 1995. Since the Rostock Airport was closed to the G8 summit, all flights were diverted here. Also serves the heliport of police, federal police and army. In 2006, the several years of the domestic [Regional Air](#) three times a week operated Munich target has been set. 2007 Greece was served with individual flights. From May 2009, joined the Bulgarian airline [Hemus Air](#) to the airport once a week with Varna. Due to low utilization of these flights were discontinued prematurely in the same year.

Parts of the former estate of the 3rd LVD air forces of the NVA were taken over by the armed forces and are now used by the Air Force Maintenance Group 22 of the Air Force Maintenance Regiment 2nd

Expected in 2015 as part of the deployment concept for 2011 was the military part of the airport to be closed.

The first step in this direction began in 2012 but with the attitude of convoys through the IL-76 to Afghanistan.
