SCENERY AND FLIGHTS IN FORGOTTEN NORTH TERRITORIES OF QUEBEC, Canada

Sainte-Anne-des-Monts is a city in the Gaspésie—Îles-de-la-Madeleine region of the province of Quebec in Canada. It is here where Gaston DuPellier started "Sea Lion Air Service" back in 1948 with a war weary C-47. Many villages were covered by Gaston bringing much needed fuel, passengers, mail and supplies. Today Avelar, his grandson still flies to not very well known villages which are the main routes of this small but efficient Air Service.....

Scenery/Flight 1: A passenger/Mail run from the Base Station of SL Air Service to EPIQUAT VILLAGE NORTH on the Asteroid Impact lake Manicouagan. The weather is fair today but it is cold.

Scenery/Flight 2: Flying the amphibian to PIKUNQUAT Village by the shores of Mistery Owl Lake. The Chatoowee Indians have been living here for over 300 years. You will be carrying much needed fuel and ammution which they need for winter heating and hunting.

Scenery/Flight 3: SAR flight.....Two Tourists driving around RED MOOSE RESERVE have radioed that they are lost. They left LA GRANDE-4 three days ago and were heading to Le Parisvous Deer & Fowl Nature Park located near Lac Bienville.CHECK THE RESERVE AREA. Another Helicopter Flight!

**Scenery/Flight 4-5:....A NIGHT flight in bad weather
From: UMIUJAQ (CYMU) TO TORKAT VILLAGE (CY09) and EPIQUAT VILLAGE. This can be considered an Emergency flight since you are taking doctors and nurses to these villages which have been hit by a winter flu epidemic....**
